



**Mobile Phone,
Camera,
Tablet
and Handbag Policy**



for Parents and Visitors

The aim of the above policy is to safeguard and protect children from harm, by ensuring the correct use of mobile phones, tablets and cameras by all individuals who enter our Nursery environment. Staff and students are all trained to understand the importance of safeguarding issues and have their own policy and procedures to follow to protect children in their care.

Parents and Visitors mobile phones, tablets and cameras Policy

1. Parents and visitors are respectfully required to refrain from entering the premises whilst using their mobile phones or tablets. Phone or tablet use must be finished please before entering the premises. Parents and visitors similarly, are required not to bring in cameras and take photographs at any time.
2. Parents and visitors must not use or answer their mobile phones when they are on the Nursery premises collecting or dropping off their child/children.
3. The Nursery wishes to extend the above safeguarding exercise by requesting that parents refrain from letting children bring into Nursery any of the above equipment.

Parents and Visitors Handbags

Parents and visitors are required to ensure that handbags are kept securely fastened and kept on their shoulders at all times out of children's reach.

Nursery tours, Nursery tasters and any visitor to the Nursery will be asked to secure their handbags on arrival protecting children from potentially dangerous items they have in their bags e.g. medication/mobile phones etc.
