Westfield, 94 Lancaster Road was built in 1879, during Queen Victoria's reign and was the first of the three storey large houses built opposite the Newcastle-under-Lyme School. It remained a private family house until circa 1943. It was then purchased by a senior member of the Sherwin's music business. We understand that this was when it first became known as The Lyme School. The business changed hands three times over the next 54 years until I took over in 1997 as the fifth owner and in 2013 it became a limited company. This year we see the business celebrate its 80th birthday and also 50 years of my time in child education. Richard.
