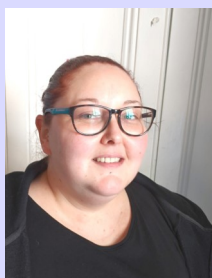

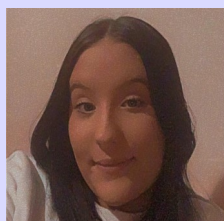
Who's who here at Nursery
